- **The Crown of Glory:** This crown is reserved for the faithful shepherds of Gods people. The pastors, elders, and other spiritual leaders. This crown honors their dedication to nurturing and guiding a flock of Gods people.
- **The Crown of Rejoicing:** This is for those who have been instrumental in leading others to the faith in Christ. It seems as if the converts themselves are the source of flow for this joyful reward. **1 Thessalonians 2:19-20**

- Look at **Mark 25:23** – “*Well done my good and faithful servant... Enter into the joy of your Lord.*”
